A new year is upon us, full of promise and possibility, a gift from the One who makes all things new. We enter the new year with confidence because our Lord Emmanuel holds you and me, he holds this world he so loves, and he holds our past, present, and future in his hands.

THE FULL MOON IN JANUARY 2020

Look skyward on the night of Friday, January 10, 2020, to spot the first full Moon of the year: the shining Full Wolf Moon. The full Moon will rise from the horizon around sunset that day.

January's full Moon will reach peak fullness—meaning 100% of its face will be illuminated—at 2:21 P.M. EST on the 10th, but it will not be visible until later that day.

The full Moon for January was called the Full Wolf Moon because wolves were more often heard at this time. It was traditionally thought that they howled due to hunger, but there is no evidence for this. However, wolves do tend to howl more often during winter months, and generally howl to define territory, locate pack members, and gather for hunting.

Many churches will celebrate Epiphany on Sunday, January 5. British tradition dictates that Christmas decorations stay up until the Twelfth Night. Most Christian groups begin counting the day after Christmas to get to the twelfth day on January 6. Others count Christmas Day to celebrate on January 5.
