- Quite a lengthy discussion was held regarding our communication with CRMC and the possible need for the church to be used for rehabilitation of future Covid19 patients and our preparedness for that use.
- Several issues in regard to employees and the shelter-in-place situation as well as remote working possibilities were discussed. Pending legislation will impact any decision on furloughing folks. Some church related work is considered essential so the weekly worship service taping can continue. Outreach gave an update on their current operating scenario, including home delivery of essential supplies to Salem members.
- Kennedy Niska has requested use of church space for personal music lessons. The Council supports this request. Details to be worked out, should Kennedy decide to pursue this venture.
- Some clarification will be sought regarding questions on the proposed LED sign.
- The Council has also begun preliminary discussion on the possible need for a short term credit line.
- Mark will check on insurance for both the Kennedy Niska request and the possible use of the church by CRMC.
